Census 1911

1 Albion Place, Leith, described as having three rooms each with a window, and five in residence.

John Temple, head of the house, age 31, funeral undertaker cab/carriage hirer, native of Galashiels. Married five years.

Birth certificates reveal Thomas and Jean were born at Grange Court, Edinburgh

Death certificate reveals John's home address was 102 Mill Street, Selkirk, and he died at Overfield Nursing Home in the town on April 9, 1955 at the age of 76. His parents were Thomas Temple, tailor, and Sarah Temple, ne Gray. (both deceased).

Church records show Thomas was born on September 1, 1854, son of John Temple, wool sorter in Earlston, and Agnes Tait.

Death certificate shows Thomas, a tailor, died at 1 Roxburgh Street, Galashiels - usual address 52 Kirk Brae - on September 2, 1902 one day after his 48th birthday although the entry has him as 46. Heart disease was the cause. His parents were John Temple, woolsorter (deceased) and Agnes Temple, ne Tait.

Death certificate shows Sarah Temple, widow of Thomas Temple, tailor/cutter, died at Old Mill, Innerleithern, on July 8, 1928, age 70. Influenza and pneumonia. Father was Edward Gray, shoemaker and Elizabeth Gardener.
